WORLD DAY OF THE SICK Blessings of the sick.

On February 11, the Catholic Church marks the World Day of the Sick each year. We offer prayers for those suffering from illness and their caregivers. The Catholic Church celebrates this annual World Day on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. This year's observance theme is "Take care of him: Compassion as a synodal exercise of healing." drawn from the Gospel of Luke on the Parable of the Good Samaritan. As the Church marks World Day of the Sick, it encourages everyone to pray for those who suffer from illness and their caregivers. There will be a special prayer and a blessing for the sick with the Blessed Sacrament on Friday, February 9, following the Holy Mass at 9 am. There will be a special blessing for the sick at each Holy Mass on the weekend of February 10/11.

SAINT BLAISE'S BLESSING

St. Blaise's throat blessing is among the oldest and most popular devotions. St. Blaise was bishop of Sebaste in Cappadocia (modern Turkey) and was martyred about A.D. 316. There are numerous legends about St. Balise. One day- so goes the legend- Blaise helped a poor woman deliver her small farm from wolves using a torch. When the bishop was imprisoned, the women brought him tapers to dispel the darkness and gloom. A miraculous cure for a boy who almost died from choking on a bone. From this account comes the old tradition of invoking St. Blaise's intercession for all sorts of throat trouble. St. Blaise's blessing will be administered in our church on Friday, February 2nd, following the Holy Mass at 9 am and before the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

BLESSING OF CANDELS

The Feast of Presentation traditional candle blessing will take place at the same Holy Mass. (Publish Jan 28)


HOLY LENT

Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully.
