Please note that this survey serves as a consultation, and any proposed changes must be approved by the bishop, which may take some time.

One proposed change is to shift the Saturday Vigil Holy Mass time to 6:00 PM, providing an alternative to the existing 5:00 PM Mass in most churches around and allowing ample time for dinner or other activities afterward.

Additionally, there has been a suggestion to adjust the 8:15 AM Mass to 8:00 AM, and the 11:45 AM Mass to 12:00 PM, to commence Mass at the top of the hour for easier recollection. The 10:00 AM Mass remains unchanged. We also welcome individual comments in the survey for further input. Please go to our website home page to participate.
