A Message from the Parish Finance Council

Dear Parishioners.

I believe that we are starting to make our way back to more "normal" times financially speaking. Receipts and Diocesan Collections both showed healthy increases from the previous year. This trend was also evident in our expenses and the overall result for the year was very similar to the previous year. We were once again able pay all our bills and ended the year with a respectable surplus of over \$43,000.

Some specific items of interest from 2023:

- Sunday Collections showed an increase of 11.7% (part of this was the result of a 53-week year in 2023 but the average weekly collection went up from under \$6,100 to over \$6,600)
- Rebates/Reimbursements/Course Fees etc. was significantly less in 2023 because we had received a \$10,000 Ontario grant to "Support Anti-Hate Security Measures for Faith Based & Cultural Organizations" in 2022
- During 2023 we received just over \$56,000 from the One Heart One Soul Campaign and left it on deposit with the Diocese to earn interest (these funds are earmarked for our Parish Youth Ministry initiatives)
- Church Salaries were down for the year as we only had one full-time priest for the full year (along with visiting priests) in 2023
- Significant increases to Repair & Maintenance costs for the church occurred again during the year which can be expected with the age of the building (sprinkler repairs, HVAC repairs, additional snow plowing expenses and increase in that contract were some of the main areas of the increase)
- Sacristy & Choir Supplies increased as a result of our Music Director retiring in August and his
 replacement's expenses being included in this category as opposed to Lay Staff Salaries (the offset
 explains the decrease in Lay Staff Salaries vs. an expected increase as there were no reduced wages
 due to COVID-19 in 2023)
- Committee Expenses increased significantly from 2022 as a result of committees and ministries getting back to normal after the COVID-19 years (2019 \$10,401, 2018 \$13,027)

Planned for 2024:

- Upgrading our Parish Youth Ministry activities using funds from the One Heart One Soul Campaign
- Inside painting of the Church

Again, this year the Finance Council has prepared a conservative budget for the current year and we will be monitoring it on an ongoing basis for any significant variances. We are also very appreciative of your continued financial support during the year.
