ST. BONIFACE CHURCH CEMETERY RESTORATION

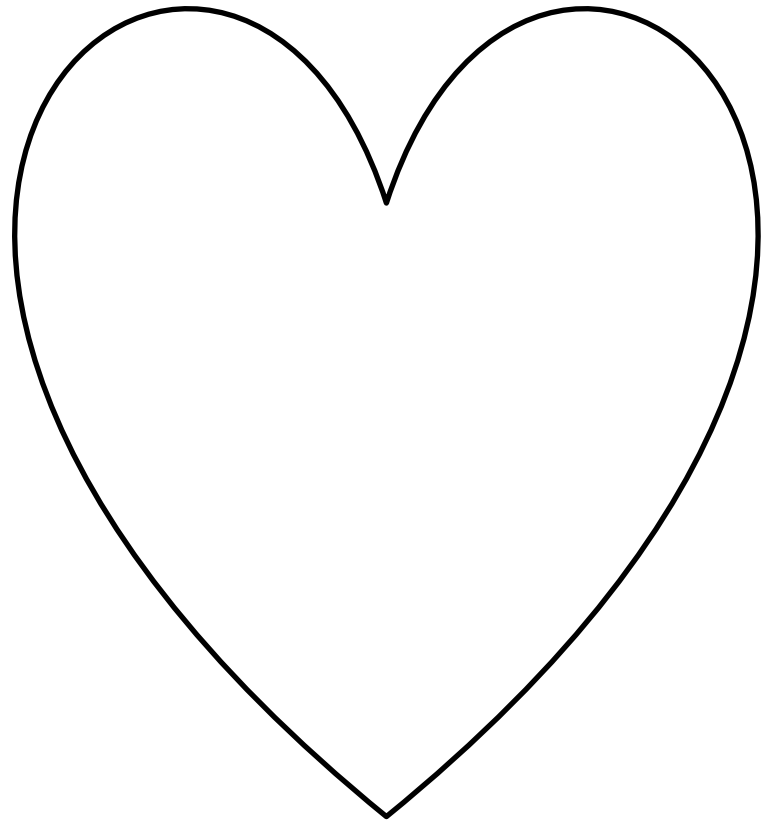
Do you have ancestors in our "Old Walled" cemetery? Even if you don't, we could use your help with the cost of preserving these precious monuments, some of which are over 175 years old. Many of the monuments most in need of attention tie directly to the original settlers of this community. Every stone is a testament to the faith, resilience, and identity of the people of Maryhill. The St. Boniface cemetery committee has hired a very reputable company that has been doing this type of work in Ontario for over 25 years. As you can imagine, it is a very labour-intensive and costly process, but crucial to the preservation of this unique heritage cemetery. This is a multi-year project with the first year alone costing over \$10,000.
