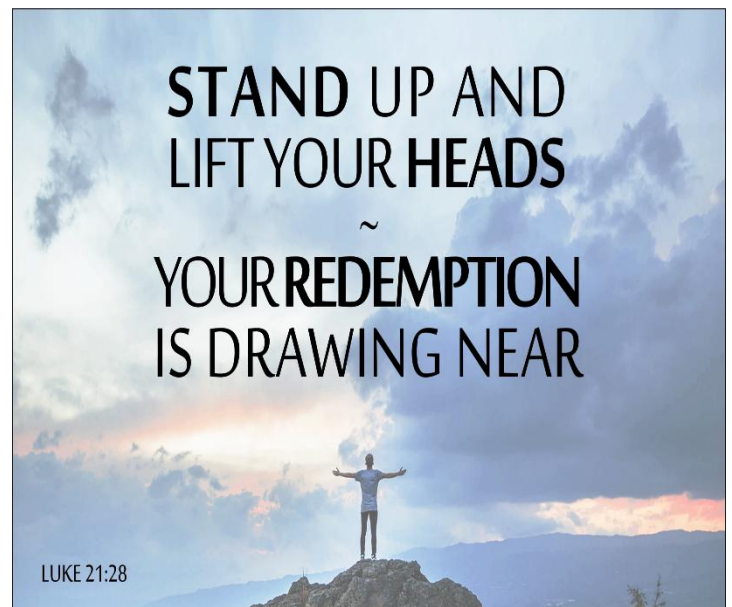

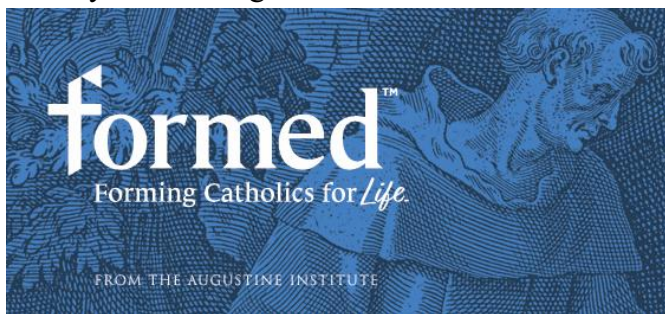
CHURCH CALENDARS
